- Our tournament winner will need to be decided via a tie-breaker. Two entrants each figured out how to respectively put together tickets worth 7.0 points. **Dennis Delesio** had a ticket with Cam Young (4.0 points) and Sam Burns (3.0 points). **Lee Zalis** had a ticket with Cam Young (4.0 points), Scottie Scheffler (1.5 points) and Tom Fleetwood (1.5 points). **Lee Zalis won the tie-breaker and the top prize of \$240.**

Tom Boyd in a big disappointment was the only golfer who used this guy Fox – who won the tournament. But he only had Scheffler to go with him so only scored 6.5 points. Many would say that his ticket was much better than Lee or Dennis' ticket. But in the end playing mostly chalk like Lee did got the job done. Congrats to the winner and those that didn't quite get it done.

- Our Day 3 winner is **Tom Boyd**. **Tom** had an entry with SW Kim and someone named Fox. **Tom's** ticket was worth 7.0 points. This ticket beats the Burns' tickets which were worth 5.0 points. **Tom wins the Day 3 prize of \$35.**
- Our Day 2 winner will need to be decided via a tiebreaker. Two entrants had Cam Young and either Burns or DeChambeau. **Dennis Delesio** had Young and Burns. **John Barilla** had Young and DeChambeau. Both tickets are worth 3.3 points. Barilla and Bryson got robbed. **John wins the Day 2 tiebreaker and \$35.**
- Our Day 1 winner is **John Barilla**. He had an entry that included two golfers in the top 5. They are DeChambeau and Young. A few others had one player. Either DeChambeau, Young or Macintyre (or McIntyre) – I think they're the same person. **John wins the Day 1 prize of \$35.**
- Our total prize fund is \$345.
